
- How to begin your livestream with a PowerPoint

Remember! You should already have OBS set up and should be getting ready for your livestream about 5 minutes in advance of your scheduled time.

Time to Stream (livestreaming members):


Step 1: Open OBS


It should look something like this, because you should have already set-up your camera and desktop



Step 2: Click on Start Streaming under the controls section

Remember that once you click this, you are live (there is a slight delay from when you start streaming until Twitch picks it up, so be mindful of that).





You'll know you're streaming when you see the green box and live function at the bottom of the screen

Step 3: Minimize OBS and pull up your presentation




This is what your screen will look like with a PowerPoint in presenter mode:




Time to Stream (members answering questions):

Step 1: Log onto Twitch


Step 2: Go to Creator Dashboard (click on your icon in the top right corner)
