## WGST [4003/5003A]: Traversing Feminisms – Foundational Skills and Theories

This course is structured as a blended learning seminar to introduce debates about gender, sexuality, class, race/ethnicity and their societal and cultural expressions, feminist theories, and social movements. The course emphasizes the importance of feminism for knowledge, learning communities, and sustainable scholarly practices. The course uses a mix of class meetings and asynchronous activities.
