WGST 4800A/4801A/5902A Practicum/Internship

The practicum gives students an opportunity to work alongside professionals in a governmental, non-governmental, community-based, or non-profit organization. Practicum students will have hands-on experience working on social justice issues. This is a course where students will learn to apply their knowledge pertaining to women's and gender studies in a policy- or practice-oriented work environment. Students will be evaluated on their ability to connect theory and practice in a variety of ways: through written diaries documenting gains in experiential knowledge, supervisor's evaluations, and class participation.

Students will be required to meet during the scheduled class time a few times during the semester.
