

Research Excellence Award

Due to the impact of COVID-19, the normal two-year time period for recognizing the candidate's research contribution has been extended to three years.

This Award of Excellence recognizes excellence and leadership in research by a FPA faculty member over the preceding three years. One award may be given each year per professorial rank (assistant professor; associate professor; full professor).

Criteria for Award

The Research Award will be awarded based upon the candidate's record of research in the past three years. The record should demonstrate excellence and leadership that has made a significant contribution to their field of research, appropriate to stage of career.

Applications

Faculty must self-apply. Chairs/Directors and faculty colleagues are encouraged to approach the faculty member to express their support and to encourage their application. Only self-nominations will be considered

Application Package

Applicants must provide:

- current curriculum vitae
- identification of the specific achievements to be recognized with a description of their contribution to the field (limit of two pages)
- letter of support from a senior scholar within Carleton University who is familiar with the work of the applicant/nominee (individual or team)

Award Recognition

The recipient of each award will receive a \$1,500 taxable cash award and an engraved award statuette. They will also be profiled by the Faculty to recognize their achievement.

Procedures and Selection Committee

Applications should be submitted via e-mail to Stephanie Bourk (stephanie.bourk@carleton.ca), Office of the Dean, Faculty of Public Affairs, by March 15, 2023. The selection committee for the Research Excellence Award is chaired by the Associate Dean, Research and International. The award selection committee membership will consist of past FPA Research Excellence Award. The selection committee will make its recommendation to the Dean.

Past FPA Research Excellence Award Winners

Past winners are eligible to re-apply five years after receipt of their last award.

Please note that since the Office of the Dean sponsors these awards, faculty and professional staff working in the Office of the Dean are not eligible for these awards nor are they able to provide nominations or letters of support for others.
