

Board 11a - Updating research process



The aim of this Board is to organize and select relevant information about the research process, and confirm current choices or envision alternatives to current ones when necessary.

This Board consist of two parts:

A) outline the current research process and its features (to be filled before Day 3);

B) draft alternatives, when necessary, on the current research choices and process (to be filled during Day 3).

Part B: Fill in the blank template to the right of the instructions template during Day 3. Write the main methodological principles of your process choices with your peers; write down new possibilities, insights or the former ones if confirmed.

1) You will have 5 minutes to present and describe the current research process using Part A.

2) You will have 15 minutes to fill Part B by discussing your current choices and emerging reflections (from pre Day 2, and post Day 2 activities). Provide insights on the process and insights for improving the process based on experience.
