Instructions

This board aims at promoting a reflection on the chosen design methodological principles and how/if they will be applied with the project participants/who is affected by the issue/opportunity. Those principles were listed in Board 1 (see: "List the principles behind the design choices"). In regard to the participants and who is affected by the issue/opportunity, they were identified in Board 2 (see: "Who does this issue/opportunity affect?").

1) In the first row (green row) write the main methodological principles you identified in Board 1. Write each principle on one white post-it. One post-it for each column. The graphic structure provided is exemplificative: you can add more greengrey-yellow column if necessary;

2) In second row (grey row) write the name of the "who" identified in Board 2: they can be project. Write each one on one white post-it. You can add more post-its and arrows if

3) In the third row (yellow row) write how that principle is applied with that participant or affected category. Use one white post-it for each one. You can add more post-its and arrows if necessary.

- Add or delete columns if necessary;
- Use sticky notes to fill in each field, use as many sticky notes as needed;
- Change font size if necessary;
- Colours of sticky notes can be changed and used to connect ideas.
