GEOD@C 2022 - Event Rules

Eligibility

- Attendees from all backgrounds, genders, and geographies are welcome. There is no age restriction to attend the event. If you are under 18, your parent/legal guardian should contact the event to request a waiver authorizing you to attend and submit their plan for your attendance and transportation to and from the event.
- There is no country restriction but you must be eligible to receive prizes. You are responsible for paying any taxes on the prize winnings if any.

Code Submission

- All participants should hold a GitHub account.
- Create a GitHub repository for your project.
- The project repository should have the following:
 - The contributors/team members should be listed in the readme along with contact details (after judging is complete the contact details may be removed)
 - Brief biographies of each team member;

- Short abstract of the project;
- Any assets used in the project;
- Any libraries used in the project; and,
- Any components not created at the event.
- All projects should be submitted to the event GitHub account (TBA) before judging begins. Failure to submit will result in disqualification from prizes. Submission to the event GitHub means part of your code may be used in generating the challenge dataset.
- All projects submissions may be randomly code-reviewed. Code created during the event should be your own work, created during the event.
