

Carleton University 2026 Geography Sports Camp Jobs

Are you interested in using your Geography knowledge and gaining experience in educational outreach? Do you have experience working with kids in a summer camp setting? Then we are looking for you!

Two positions are available for the summer of 2026. The geography camp will run two weeks, August 10th to 14th and August 17th to 21st. It is geared toward 8- to 12-year-olds. We will have two groups of 25 campers each day engaging in geography programming, with one group visiting us in the morning and another in the afternoon.

Geography Summer Camp, 2026 Camp Program Manager:

The Camp Geography Program Manager will be responsible for the daily operations of the camp at a rate of \$19.80 per hour. Hours are 8:30am until 4:30pm with lunch break including a free cafeteria lunch. The Program Manager will work with the Program Officer before the week of camp as part of prep for the camp.

Duties will include:

Prior to camp: with the assistance of the Program Officer, the Camp Manager will:

- design, prepare and organize camp activities, hand-outs, equipment and any other required materials
- prepare activity introduction PowerPoints/presentations
- prepare additional activities to use if we have extra time, including websites to investigate, videos,

During camp weeks: Camp Manager will:

- introduce and explain camp activities to campers
- direct and assist with set-up and clean-up of camp activities each day
- ensure next day's activities are ready to go at the end of each day
- with the help of the Camp Assistant, lead campers through the activities

The Camp Manager will be responsible for supervision and safety of campers to keep them on task and will direct the work of the Camp Assistant and Athletics Counsellors during their time in our department.

Geography Summer Camp, 2026 Camp Program Assistant:

Geography Camp Program Assistant will assist the Camp Manager with duties related to the operation of the Geography Sports summer camp and be employed at a rate of \$17.65 per hour. Hours are 8:30am until 4:30pm with lunch break including free cafeteria lunch.

Duties will include:

- assist the Camp Manager to plan, prepare and organize all materials required for the camps
- assist Camp Manager to set up and clean up activity materials each day
- assist campers with activities
- help to supervise campers to ensure safety and focus on activities
