Practical Matters	
Accommodation	Ilia State University does not have a student dormitory, however, visiting students and staff can receive guidance and support from IRO in finding housing options according to their preferences. The prices for a furnished studio in a central area range from 400 to 500EUR, while the prices for a shared apartment in a normal/peripheral area range from 300 to 400EUR per month.
Cost of Living	The local currency in Georgia is Georgian Lari (GEL). In addition to tuition fees and housing costs, around 300-400EUR per month is recommended to meet expenditures on food, transportation, phone and other personal needs.
Visa Information	List of countries, whose citizens may enter Georgia without a visa: https://www.geoconsul.gov.ge/en/entering-georgia EU citizens/permanent residency holders are free to enter and stay in Georgia for up to 1 year without a visa.
Insurance	In Georgia, it is not mandatory to have any specific health insurance. However, we strongly recommend that students obtain insurance in their country of residence. If a student wishes to have Georgian health insurance, IRO can provide information on several student insurance packages from which students can choose their preferred option.
