Language Requirements	If English is not your first language, you need to pass an English language test: Erasmus students can use the OLS Toefl (you have to obtain at least 80 in the computer based Toefl test) Cambridge (you have to obtain at least B2 in the Cambridge test) IELTS (you have to obtain at least 6.5 in the IELTS test) If you have studied at least one year in an English language environment, the language test may be waived.
