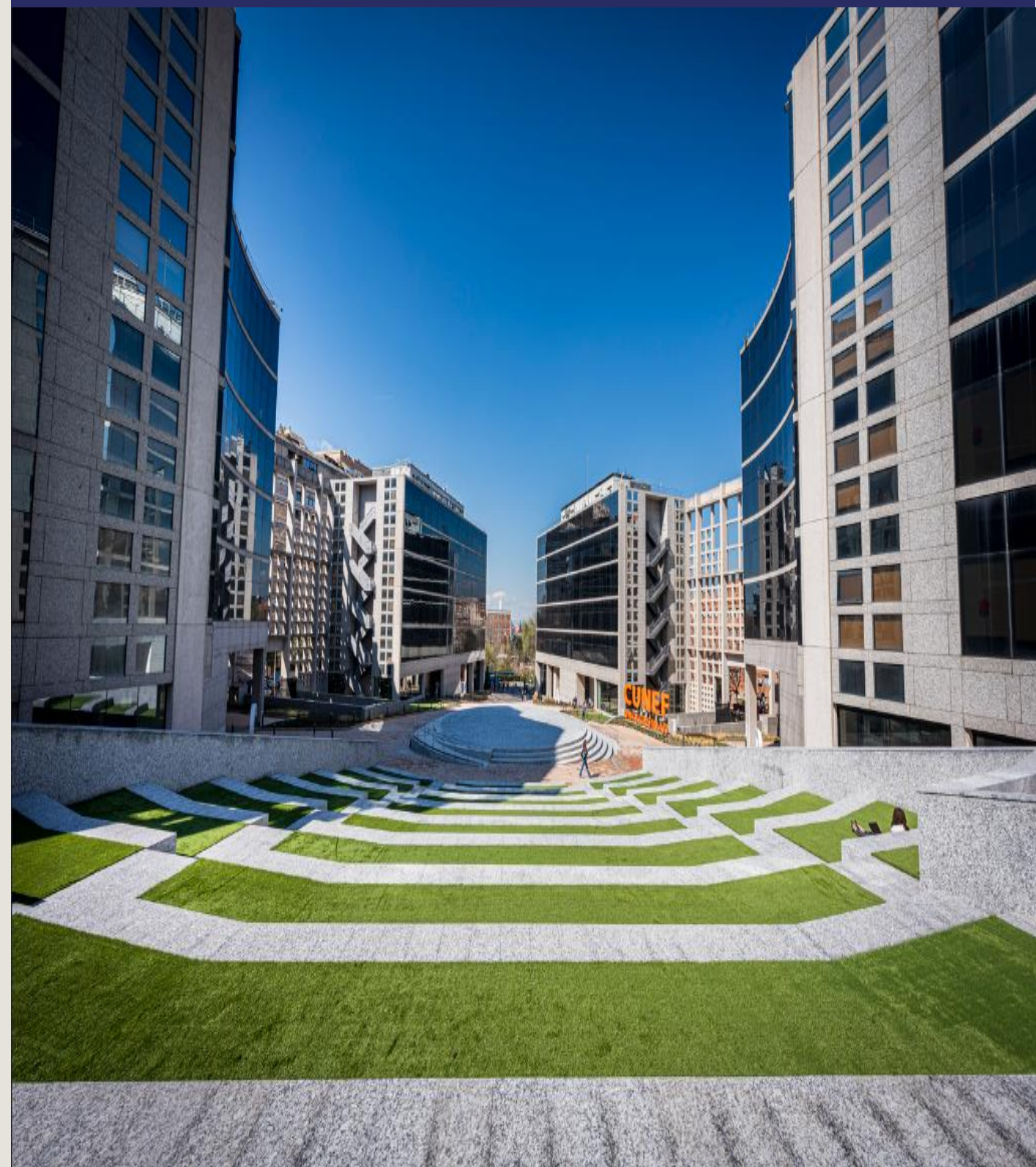

1 Semester = 30 ECTS* 1 Academic year = 60 ECTS*	ECTS are calculated based on the amount of class hours per week. CUNEF offers 3 ECTS and 6 ECTS courses. 3 ECTS courses usually have 1 session of 1 hour 30 minutes per week, while 6 ECTS courses tend to have 3 sessions of 1 hour per week.

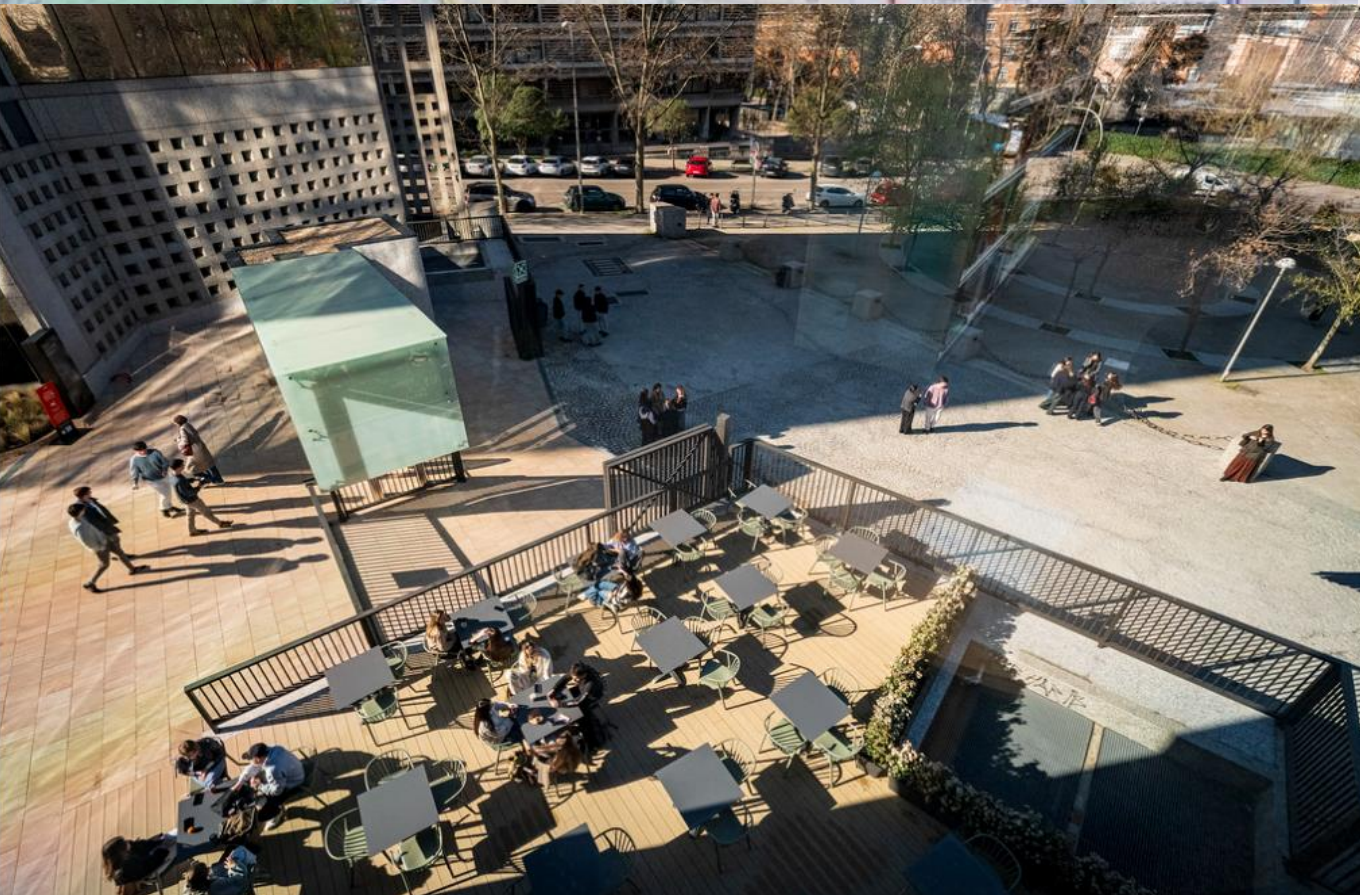
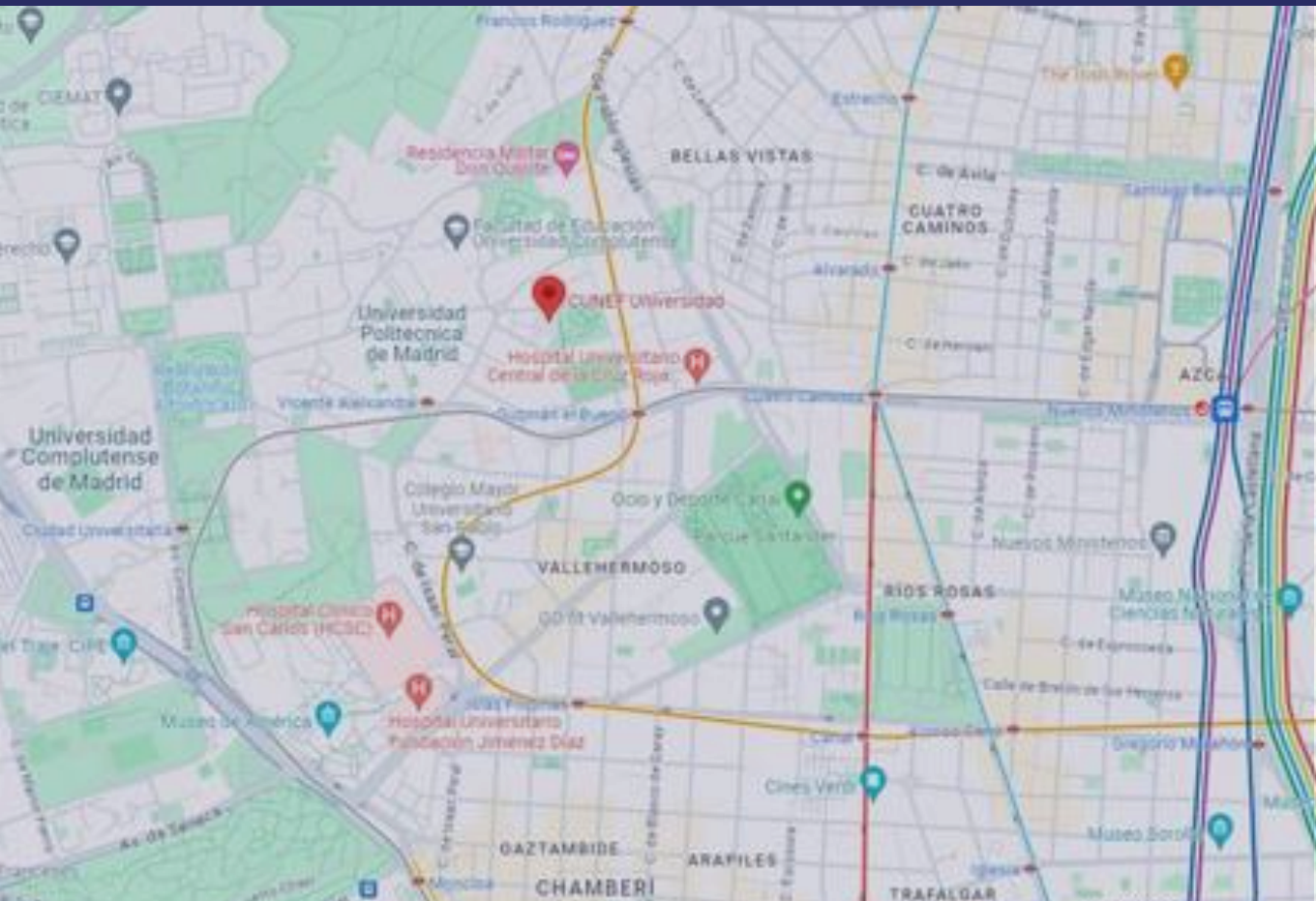
The Forum gives students the opportunity to learn directly from prospective employers about the most in-demand profiles, their recruitment processes, and the corporate culture of participating organizations.

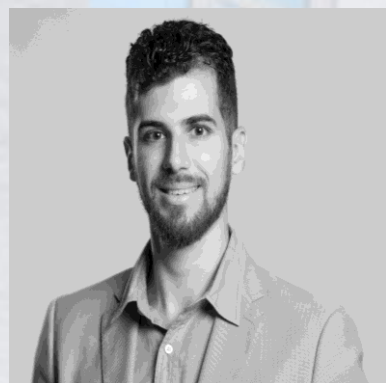
