








Nomination and Online Application Procedures

NOMINATION	Sending institutions must nominate students through the Online Nomination Form. Deadlines Fall Semester and Full Year stays, 30th April 2025 Spring Semester: 28th September 2025
ONLINE APPLICATION	Once nominated, students will receive a confirmation from our International Office, together with an incoming student guide and a link to do their Online Application on our MoveOn platform. Deadlines • Fall Semester (S1): 31st May 2025 • Spring Semester (S2): 20th October 2025 Students are not required to select their classes at this point yet.
ACCEPTATION	WARNING: selected classes before the arrival can be modified during the first week of the stay, due to last-minute timetable modifications.
COURSE CHANGES	Course change requests will be acceptable depending on the <u>sports availability</u> . Enrolment modification period S1: within a month since the exchange started
