Nomination dates

Monday 10 February 2025 – Monday 17 March 2025
(via online nomination form which will be provided by email).

Nominations will be accepted for:

- Autumn or Spring semester exchange
- Full academic year

Application deadline

9am on Wednesday 23 April 2025. Information about the application process can be found on the student exchange webpage.

Undergraduate academic calendar

- Autumn semester /full academic year students are required to arrive on **Monday 15 September 2025.**
- Spring Semester only students are required to arrive on **Monday 2 February 2026.**

Language of Instruction (English)

- Applicants should be at 6.0 IELTS standard (with a minimum score of 5.5 for each skill).
- Students coming for one semester are able to provide a signed letter from the home institution indicating proficiency according to a minimum level of CEFR B2.
- Students coming on exchange for a full academic year will need to demonstrate proficiency through an official test.

DMU offers English language tests for exchange students to determine their language level.

English language support

All international students are entitled to 2 hours English language tuition per week.

Teaching structure

Teaching model

DMU delivers undergraduate programmes in a Block Teaching format. This consists of studying one block (module) worth 30 credits (15 ECTS) at a time. Two blocks will be delivered per semester. Some exceptions may apply.
