

GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION AGREEMENT FOR NON-RESIDENTS OF CANADA

The medico-legal guidelines in Canada require that all non-residents requesting health care sign an agreement entitled "Governing Law & Jurisdiction Agreement for Non-Residents of Canada" regarding due process in the event of any medico-legal concerns. This binding agreement covers all health care received at Carleton University Health & Counselling Services.

Governing Law

I hereby agree that the relationship and the resolution of any and all disputes arising therefrom between myself and *any of the attending doctors at Carleton University Health & Counselling Services*, including any issues related to this Agreement, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of Ontario and the laws of Canada applicable therein.

Jurisdiction

I hereby acknowledge that the treatment will be performed in the province of Ontario and the that Courts of the province of Ontario shall have exclusive and preferential jurisdiction to entertain any complaint, demand, claim, proceeding or cause of action, whatsoever arising out of the treatment. I hereby agree that if I commence any such legal proceedings, I will do so only in the province of Ontario, and hereby irrevocably submit to the exclusive and preferential jurisdiction of the Courts of the province of Ontario.
