Hours and pay: Up to 20 hours of work equivalent to \$25 per hour (up to a maximum of \$500 + 4% vacation pay).

Please note that the student will be responsible for managing their time, keeping the supervisor abreast of their progress, and ensuring that they are staying within the anticipated budget – any changes must be communicated to and approved by the supervisor ahead of time (i.e., at least two weeks in advance).

Project: Under the direction of an ALDS (Applied Linguistics and Discourse Studies) faculty, the student will provide design support for the development of a proceedings Pressbook for a graduate Capstone Project course; they may also be tasked with uploading elements to the Pressbook. This e-book will be developed in Pressbooks to showcase research projects of three (3) graduate students completing their one-year MA in TEAL (Teaching English as an Additional Language). The compilation will include both text and video elements.

This project will benefit the student, who will:

- 1. Learn the Pressbooks platform,
- 2. Experience and benefit from a co-design process based on real client needs, and
- 3. Develop the ability to conceptualize and finalize graphic content for clear communication.
