APPLICATION


The online application will open in September and close in November. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to participate in a Selection Process, which will take place in Montreal in late January. Up to 12 successful Fellows will be notified in late February that their Pathy Foundation Fellowship journey has begun!



PRE-COMMUNITY TRAINING

Fellows will spend 3-4 weeks in June participating in the Foundations for Community Change workshop at Coady International Institute in Antigonish, Nova Scotia. Fellows then have a two-month period to fine-tune their initiative plans before returning to Coady in August for a Final Planning Workshop.





Fellows will spend nine months working in and with their chosen communities, with ongoing Coady support and personal leadership coaching.

COMMUNITY PHASE



DEBRIEFING AND EVALUATION

Fellows will return to Coady in May for a final one-week Debrief and Evaluation session.
