Role1: Project Manager / Research Coordinator

- **Project management and coordination:**
 - Implement, monitor, and manage various research projects.
 - Coordinate and manage the collection, entry, verification, analysis, and reporting of data.
 - Develop and maintain recordkeeping systems and procedures.
- **Participant management:**
 - Recruit, screen, and enroll participants for studies.
 - Obtain informed consent from participants.
- **Compliance and regulatory oversight:**
 - Ensure all research activities adhere to the study protocol, regulatory requirements, and ethical standards.
 - Prepare and submit necessary documentation to REB
- **Data analysis and reporting:**
 - Assist with analyzing data using statistical software and interpreting the results.
 - Conduct literature reviews and apply scientific principles to interpret published literature.
 - Write sections of reports, manuscripts, and grant proposals.
- **Administrative and liaison duties:**
 - Serve as the main point of contact for the project and communicate with collaborators and stakeholders.
 - Collaborate with investigators to prepare study materials and documents.

Role2: Research Assistant

- **Conducting research:**
 - Performing literature searches, assisting with experiments, and collecting data through methods like surveys, interviews, or observation.
- **Data management:**
 - Entering, organizing, and maintaining research data, and ensuring data integrity.
- **Data analysis:**
 - Analyzing collected data using various statistical methods and software.
- **Writing and reporting:**
 - Preparing progress reports, summaries, and assisting with manuscript or grant proposals.
- **Team collaboration:**
 - Attending project meetings and providing support to other research staff.
