Mac Laptop (HDMI)

To sign out an HMDI cable and/or adapter, visit the IMS Classroom Technology Support office in Loeb D283. Once you have the HMDI cable and/or adapter, you will be able to connect it to your laptop and the classroom projector(s) by using the HMDI port located inside the teaching console.

STEP 1


Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the port inside the equipment cabinet (labeled HDMI), and connect the other end of the HDMI cable to your laptop.



Note: You may need to use an adapter



STEP 2




In single projection rooms with a keypad, select "HMDI"

In single projection rooms with a touch panel, select "Laptop" then "HDMI"



In dual projection rooms, select "Computer" or "Laptop", then "HDMI"



Note: You may need to toggle the video output of your laptop. On a Mac-based laptop, navigate to the System Preferences by clicking on the Apple icon in the top left corner of your desktop display and select System Preferences.



From the System Preferences menu, select Displays



From the Displays menu, ensure "Mirror Displays" is selected
