This year's edition seeks to explore the following theme: **International Security**. While this theme may be interpreted in many ways, this year's edition will showcase creative and rigorous submissions that focus on current strategic shifts and trends in the global landscape.

examples of topics

- the emergence of non-state actors;
- the changes in domestic and international terrorism;
- the conditions or environments within which new strategic actors operate;
- emerging security challenges, such as radicalization and migration;
- new forms of crisis and conflict, including cyber warfare;
- conflict regions, etc.

guidelines for submissions

Three types of submissions will be accepted: Research articles (should not exceed 8,000 words in length, including in-text citations and the reference list), book reviews (800-1,000 words), and policy briefs (should not exceed 1,500 words).

Submissions must include 100 to 200-word abstract, keywords, and a 100-word biography.

Citations must follow the APA style.
