2. **RELEVANCE.** Explain the relevance of the topic to the overall objectives of the IPIS program and indicate how you will integrate your knowledge from the courses taken in the program to your project or essay.
3. **RELATED RESEARCH.** Provide a brief literature review that identifies some of the principal sources for your project or essay and explain how your work will contribute to our existing knowledge of the topic, or how it may fit within or outside of the existing bodies of knowledge on the topic. If you have a preferred format for the presentation of a literature review, please provide this as you see fit.
4. **BASIC APPROACH.** Describe what you plan to do in your research and how you plan to do it, including the methods you will employ to collect and analyze information and evaluate your research question or hypothesis.
