The certificate and professional designation programs are aimed at security professionals, managers, frontline responders, operational personnel, young professionals, and recent graduates looking to improve their knowledge and skills to advance or pursue a career in security and critical infrastructure.

CERTIFICATION

Certified Security and Resilience Professional (CSARP)

The Certified Security and Resilience Professional Certification (CSARP) will be obtained when an individual attains **12 “certificates of completion”** composed of:

- **Six (6) of the following essential courses:**
 - Fundamentals of Security**
 - Essentials of Physical Security**
 - Critical Infrastructure Protection Overview**
 - Fundamentals of Information and Systems Security**
 - Information Security and Identity Management**
 - Personnel Security and Interviewing**
 - Advanced Security Management**
 - Integrated Threat Risk Vulnerability Assessment**
- **Six (6) elective courses** (from other courses offered by IRRG and its partners), and
- Successful completion of the requisite tests for each 6 essential and 6 elective courses (**70% minimum passing grade**)

DESIGNATION

Designated Security and Resilience Manager (DSARM)

The Designated Security and Resilience Manager (DSARM) is granted to an individual who has successfully completed the 6 essential and 6 elective courses; passed the testing requirements and acquired the CSARP status by taking the following courses and lectures:

- Leadership**
- Values and Ethics**
- Legislation and Regulatory Framework**

***In addition, the candidate must pass a board examination / interview**
