Cost of Living - Costs of living at STU (for reference only, non-refundable unless otherwise stated) (RMB $100 \approx CAD19.5$)

- Accommodation: RMB 6000/year (For a double bedroom.)
- Room Deposit (refundable): RMB 800
- Food: RMB1000/month approximately)
- Books and materials: RMB 500-700/year
- Miscellaneous: RMB 200-300/month (approximately)

Health Insurance

Health Insurance is required for international students studying in China. STU recommend the insurance policy offered by http://en.lxbx.net/article/baoxian-61.html The price is RMB 800yuan per student per year.

There is a health clinic on campus which is open from Monday to Friday. A doctor will be on duty for emergencies on Saturday and Sunday and after hours.

Courses

Usually exchange students at STU will take some courses offered by colleges/schools as well as some Chinese language courses offered by Chinese Language Training Centre.

Accommodation & Meal Plan

Exchange students are recommended to live on campus. The expenses of electricity and water are shared among roommates, and it will be directly deducted from STU student ID Card each month. Students are not allowed to cook at their dorms. There are four student canteens on campus where most of the students dine. Usually RMB 10-15 yuan(or even less) will be enough for lunch and dinner. Breakfast will cost less than 5 yuan.

Pre-arrival information & travel

The nearest airport to STU is Jieyang Chaoshan Airport (airport code: SWA), which is 30 minutes away from STU campus by car. STU will arrange pick up service for students. Chaoshan Train Station, which is 30 kilometres from STU, connects Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Xiamen, and Hongkong. International students can also transfer to Shantou from the above-mentioned cities by bullet trains.

Orientation & Mentoring

Currently exchange students will join an orientation programme together with international students at School of International Education. STU has student ambassadors to meet the

exchange students at the airport and help exchange students to get familiar with campus facilities, etc.

Work

International students are not allowed to work while studying at STU. But STU can offer places of internship at STU LAB or local companies.

Visa

After STU receives the application materials, International Office will complete JW202 Form application from Department of Education of Guangdong Province. JW202 Form is essential for student visa. Please note that the whole process will take one month or more. Therefore it is suggested that all students submit application materials before **May 1**.

Students have to apply for student visa (X1 visa for 1-year exchange, and X2 for 1-semester exchange) after they receive the JW202 Form and Admission Letter at the Chinese Embassy/Consulate General in Canada. For 1-year exchange students, STU will help get a resident permit after they arrive. These students are required to have a physical examination in Shantou.
