By the Korea immigration office policy strengthening, we are now requiring non-OECD nationality exchange students(D-2-6) document submission for <Letter of acceptance>, since 2022 Fall incoming students.

- 2. Submit the original copies to your home univ. program coordinator. She/he will send us the original hard copy to Sookmyung via post.
- 3. Once SMU receive the hard copy, we will be sending the <Letter of acceptance> needed for D-2-6 student visato the student.
