Membership is completely voluntary and students have the opportunity to start new clubs that allow them to grow and develop personally and professionally.

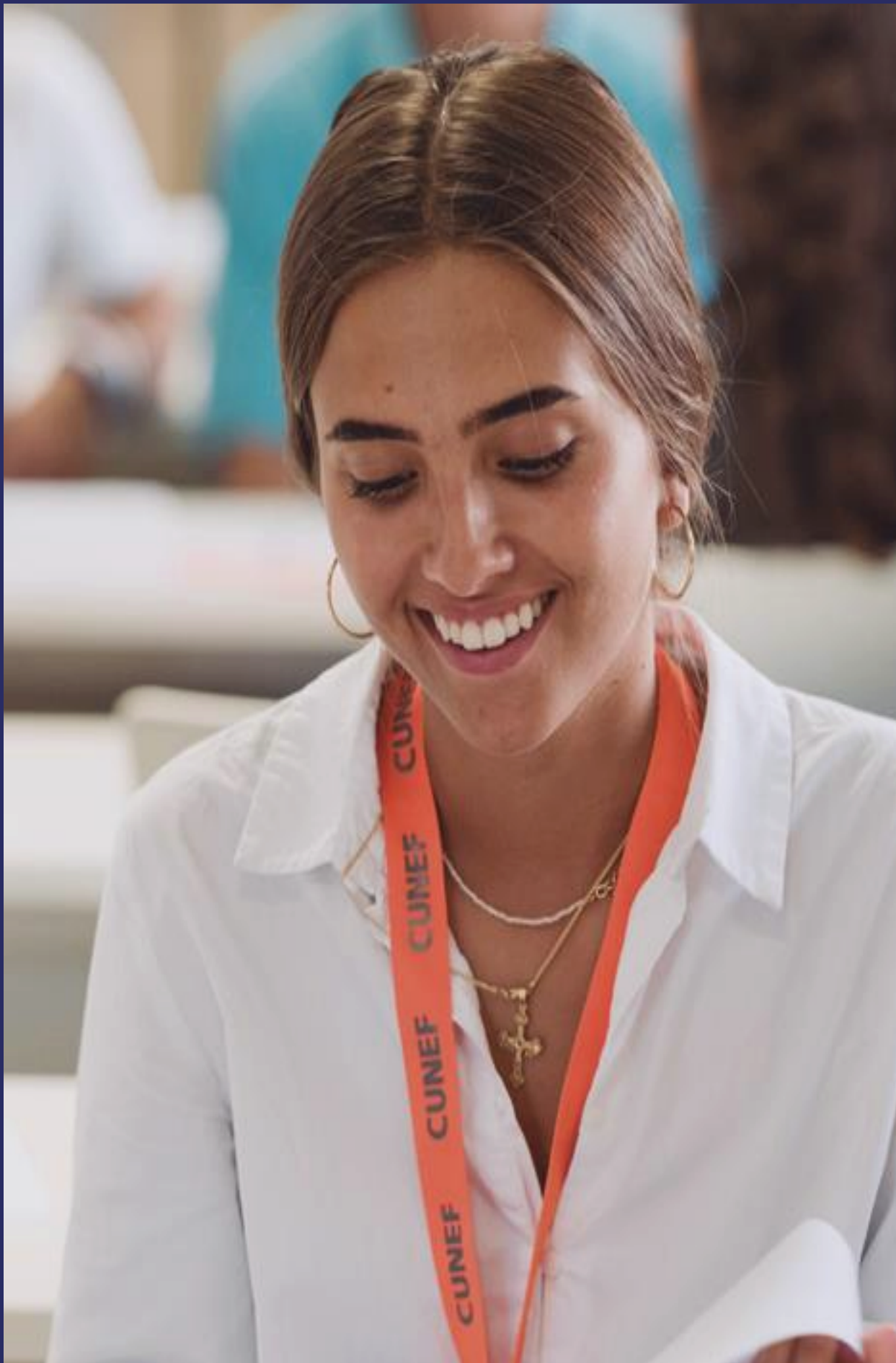

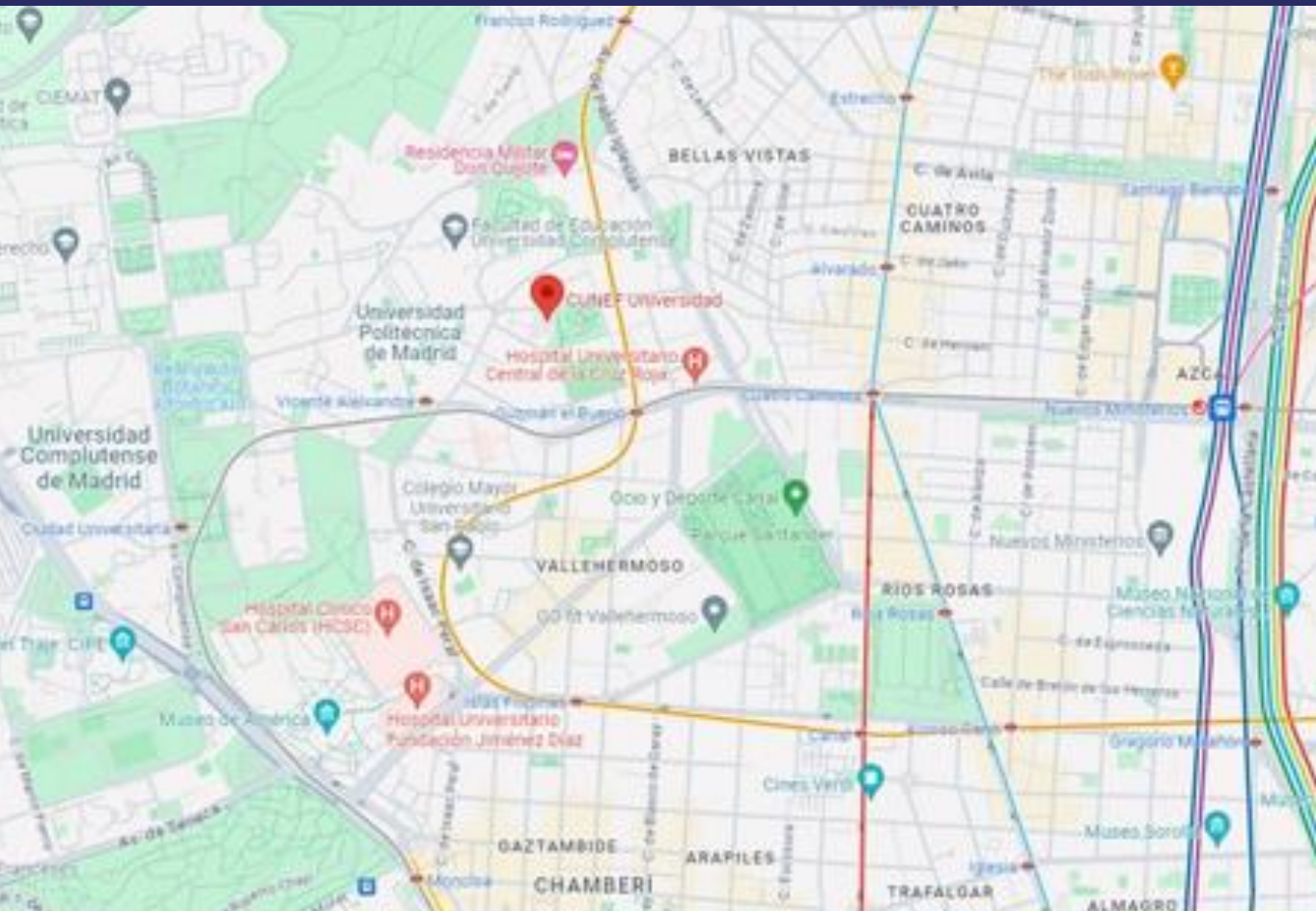
