Comparable with at least:

- 80 TOEFL (iBT min. scores of at least 20 on all components)
- 575 TOEFL (ITP min. B2 sub score)
- 6.0 IELTS overall (at least a score of 6.0 on all components)
- Level B2 (CEFR)

Students whose native language is English or whose study programme at the home university is completely taught in English, do not need to take an English proficiency test.

#### **Application procedure**

After nomination by the home university, students are invited to complete our online application form with the following required documents:

 Official Transcript of Records (starting from Bachelor year 1 to present, including courses you are currently enrolled in). All students should have completed at least one

- year of their Bachelor's degree programme
- Proof of English proficiency
- Copy of valid passport/ European ID-card
