## **Supporting Documents for Online Application**

- **Certified**\* copy of academic transcript in English demonstrating completion of at least one academic year/2 semesters).
- **Certified**\* copies of English language test results
- Passport information page (including photo)
- 500-word student statement of purpose if you are an exchange student

#### \*Certified Documents

We will accept a certified copy of documents verified by international office or authorised person at their home institution or agent.

Verifier must sight an original document and provide their full name, position, signature and date of signing to verify a copy of the original document.
