Grading system

The HEG-Fribourg uses a grading scale ranging from 0 to 6.00, with 4.00 representing a passing grade.

Transcript of records

A Transcript of Records will be issued no later than 2 months after the assessment period has finished at our institution. Transcript will be sent directly to your home institution.

Accommodation

Housing is only possible off-campus, a number of single furnished rooms within the student residence are available for incoming students. Other accommodations are available in Fribourg in shared apartments with roommates or host families around Fribourg.

Approximate cost per month in Swiss Francs (CHF)

The average cost of living for a student in Fribourg is between CHF 1,200 and CHF 2,000 per month. This includes rent (~CHF 600 to 800*), food and basic necessities (~CHF 300 to 600), and transportation (~CHF 50 to 100), leisure activities (~CHF 100 to 200).

Health Insurance

Basic health insurance is mandatory in Switzerland (accident and health) for students who wish to spend more than three months. Non-EU residents should buy Swiss health insurance (currently approx. CHF 85 - 100, per month); certain international health insurance obtained in the home country are not sufficient.

EU residents : European Health Insurance Card is recognized in Switzerland for health and accident insurance.

Visa and Residence Permit

Non-EU citizens may require a visa and must contact the nearest Swiss embassy at least 3 months before entering Switzerland in order to inquire about the visa procedure. The visa will allow entry into Switzerland.

EU and EFTA citizens do not need a visa to enter Switzerland, but like all foreign citizens they need a residence permit.

UE AND Non-EU citizens should request a residence permit from the Migration Service (SPOMI) in Fribourg
