

Sookmyung provides seven types of dormitories for International Students (exchange and degree-seeking students only). There are various options for suitable accommodations on-campus. New international students may apply for on-campus or off-campus housing. The dormitory rooms are well equipped with free internet and Wi-Fi access. The dormitory provides shared refrigerators for student use, lounge areas, a computer room, and laundry facilities (washing machines and dryers). Onsite staffs are ready to respond to the needs of students. All the accommodation types include heating and cooling systems.


