TRAVEL PROCESS FOR FULLY VACCINATED TRAVELLERS

INFORMATION IS VALID AS OF AUGUST 9, 2021, CONTACT ISSO WITH ANY QUESTIONS

Pre-Arrival Steps

- Book your airfare for travel
- Confirm that you have received a full vaccine series with a **Government of Canada accepted vaccine**
 - You must have received your last dose at least 14 days prior to your entry to Canada
- Complete the **Pre-Arrival Form** to notify the ISSO of your travel plans and vaccine status

- Gather essential travel documents such as:
 - Visa or eTA
 - Valid Study Permit
 - **Certificate of Enrolment** or Admission Letter
 - Proof of financial means (bank statements, GIC, etc)
 - Proof of valid **medical exams**, if required
 - English language test results, if they were required for your study permit application
 - University Health Insurance Card (UHIP)
 - Confirmation email from Pre-Arrival Form

- Create a document with your quarantine plan, with details on your accommodations, transportation and access to necessities in case you **do not** qualify for the exemption and are required to complete a 14-day quarantine
- Ensure you have the financial means to pay for travel and quarantine expenses
- Ensure you have access to a cellphone that works in Canada

- Submit your travel information through the ArriveCAN Mobile App, including proof of full vaccination in English or French
- Within 72 hours of scheduled flight, complete a COVID-19 PCR test and bring documentation of negative test result to the airline prior to boarding flight



After Arrival

- Take COVID-19 test at the airport if randomly selected



- Travel to final destination following Public Health Guidelines
- Inform Carleton staff that you have been exempted from quarantine
