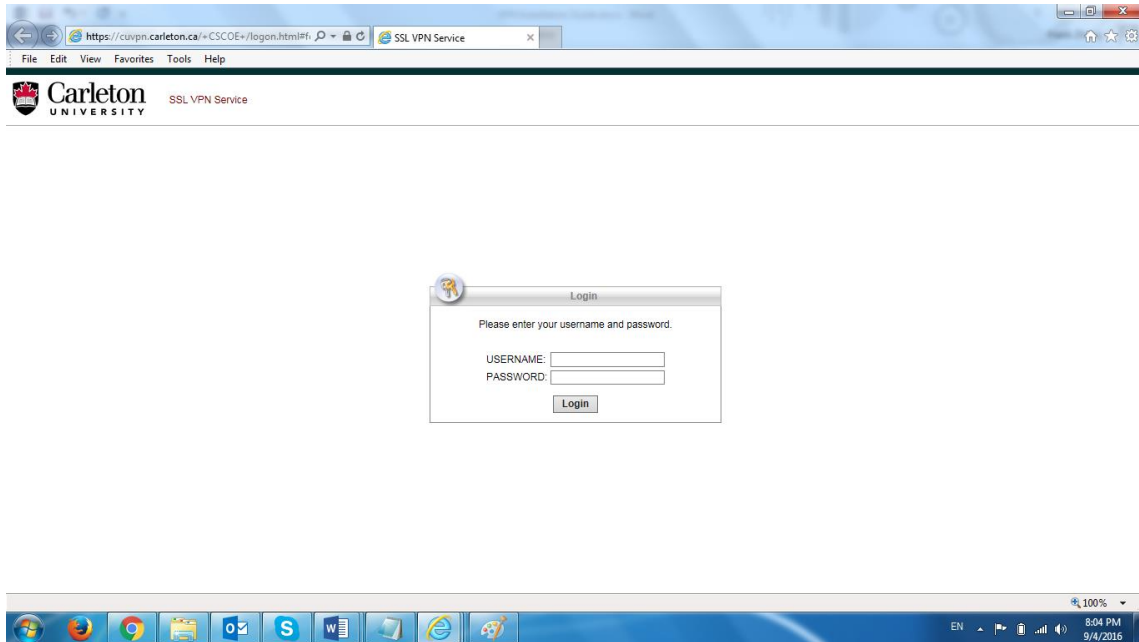
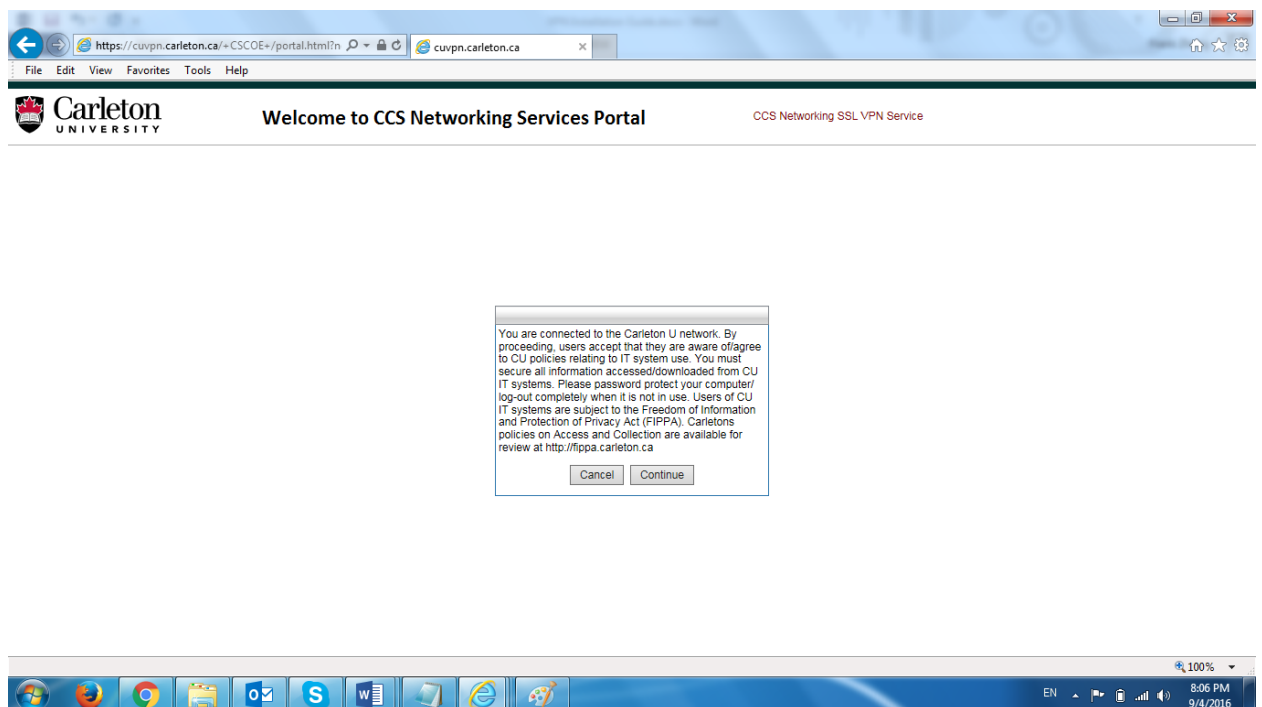


Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client for Windows 10

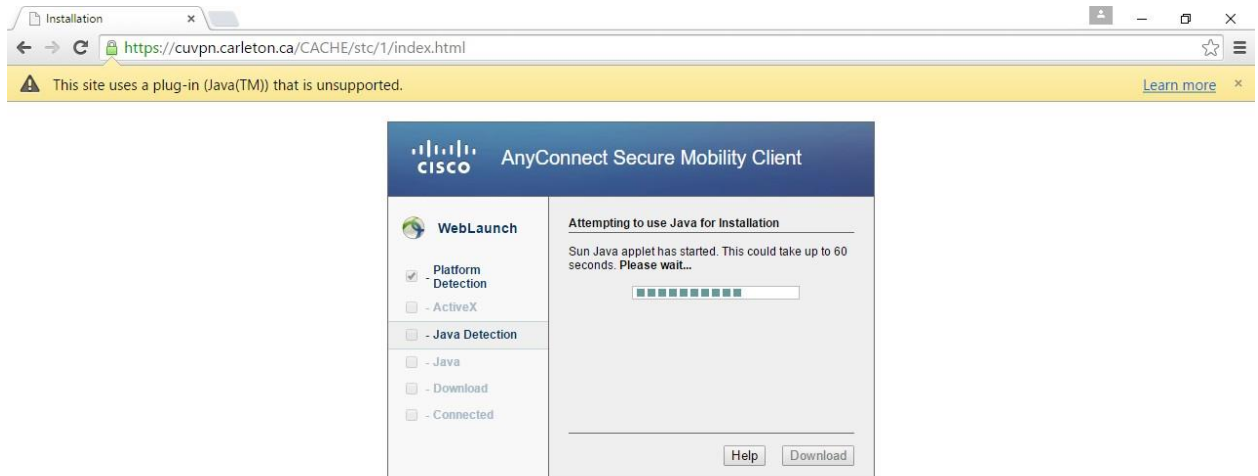
1. Go to: cuvpn.carleton.ca and login with your **MC1 Username and Password**.



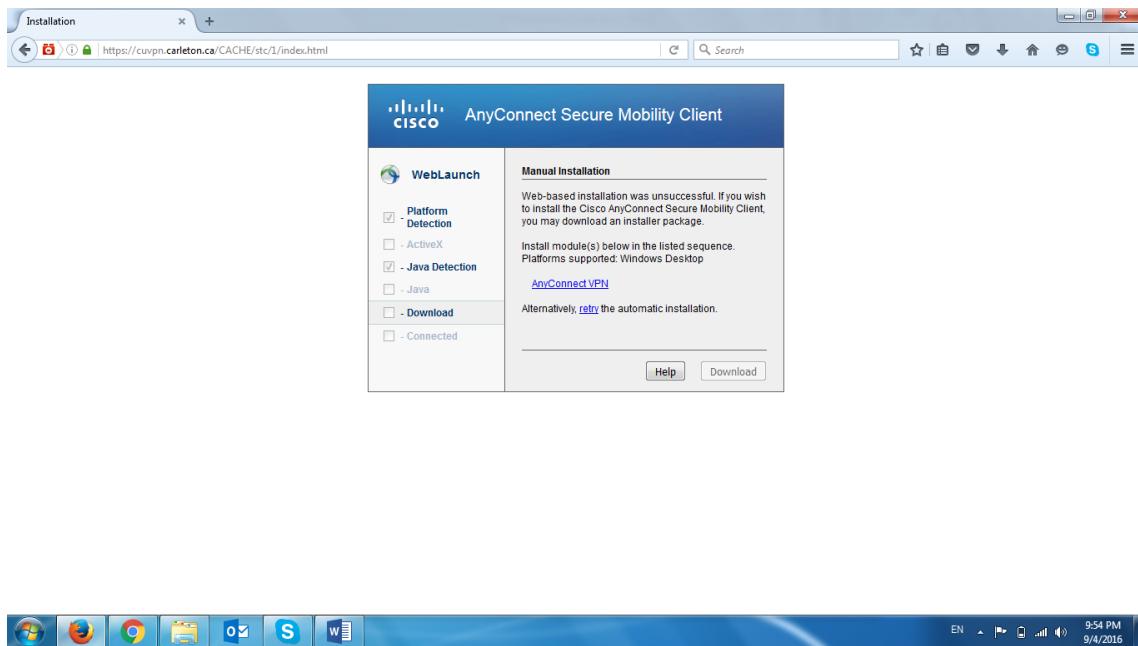
2. One the following page, client “**Continue**”.



3. Wait for “Java Detection”. This could take a couple minutes.



4. In some circumstances depending on your computer system configuration, automatic installation may fail and you will be prompted to manually download installer package. Click “AnyConnect VPN” to continue.

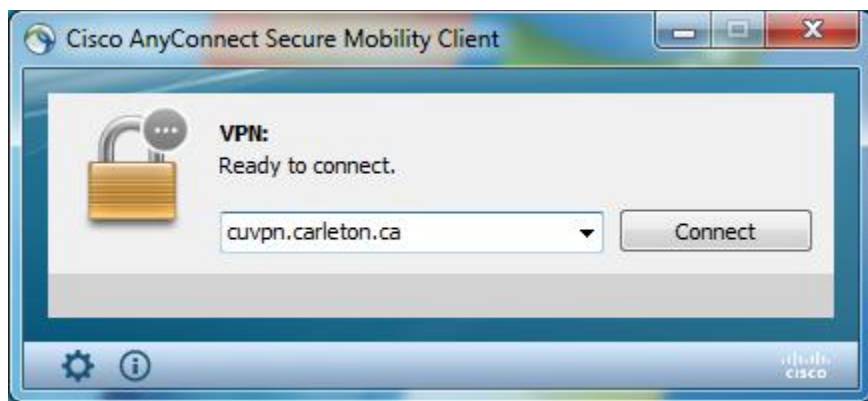


Depending on your browser: In Google Chrome, open the downloaded .exe file; In Microsoft Edge, click “Run” in the message bar at the bottom of the page; and In Mozilla Firefox, select “Save File” in the pop-up window. Click on the blue Downloads arrow in the top bar of the browser, and then click on the downloaded file.

5. Follow the prompts to have the Cisco Anyconnect Security Mobility Client Setup. If a security message appears, click “Yes” to allow the software to be installed.



6. In the future, to use the VPN Service, you can use the "Start Menu" item to launch the Cisco AnyConnect Security Mobility Client window. If the dropdown menu is empty, type **cuvpn.carleton.ca** and click “Connect”.



7. Enter your **MC1 Username and Password** and click **“OK”** to login.
