“Yerusalem” is the story of an isolated Jewish tribe who kept its faith for thousands of years even though they lived in a hostile Christian environment. In one of several clandestine operations in the Ethiopian Exodus, Israeli Mossad, the US administration, and world Jewry collaborated to rescue thousands of Ethiopian Jews from the hellhole refugee camps in Sudan. “Yerusalem” is the complex story of the Ethiopian Jewish community in Israel bringing the stories of the first and second generation of immigrants, rabbinical cases, Aliyah activists, Mossad personnel, ship commanders and pilots, decision-makers and many others who risked their lives to bring Ethiopian Jews to their ancestral land.
