To help promote student activities, a poster has been designed by Chan Ching, Judi Weaver and myself. It is now available upon request (see Fig. 1).

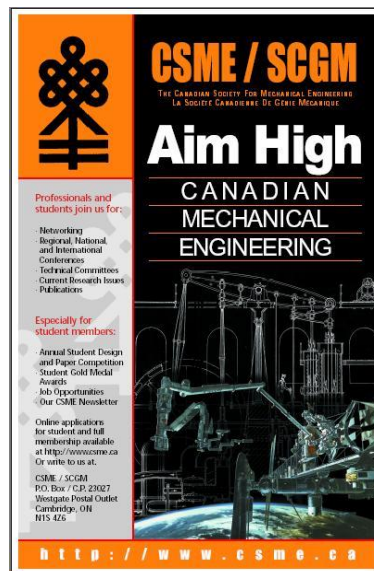
