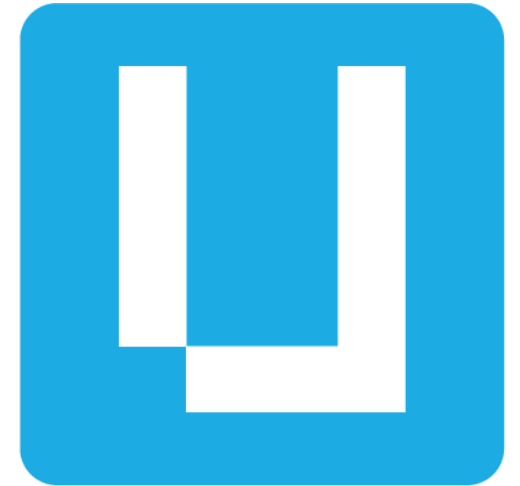

What is U-Report?

- A UNICEF polling platform to elevate youth voice
- Biweekly digital polls gather young people's opinions on issues that affect them
- Quick, easy and *real-time* (not the same as statistical data or focus groups)
- 822 U-Reporters and counting in Canada
- Active in more than 50 countries, with over 7 million U-Reporters worldwide
- *Every 30 seconds someone in the world signs up for U-Report.*

Guided by young people

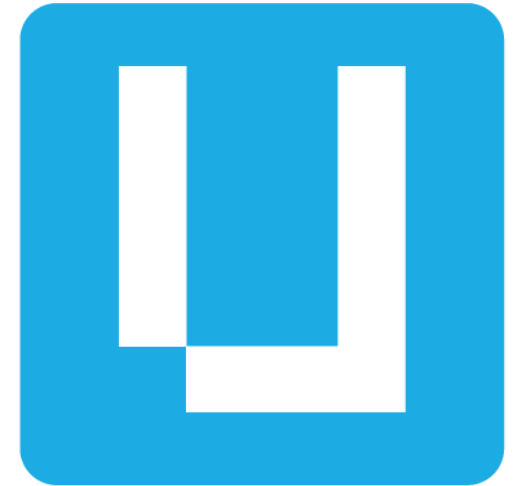
- Canadian version co-developed with youth

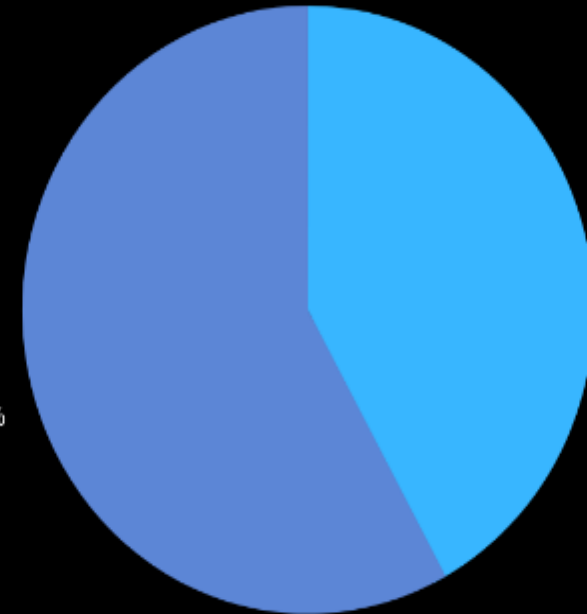
