 - a) all of the courses you wish to be considered for (as available on the Call for Applicants), and

b) the minimum/maximum number of courses you would like to teach (reminder: 2.0 credits is the limit for the Fall/Winter)

4. Finally, we require an updated CV with your application

REMINDER: No application form is required, just an e-mail with your CV.

A note to all applicants: As per Articles 16.3 and 16.4 in the CUPE 4600-2 Collective Agreement, the posted vacancies listed above are first offered to applicants meeting the incumbency criterion.
