 - b) the minimum/maximum number of courses you would like to teach (reminder: 2.0 credits is the limit for the Fall/Winter)
 - c) Your 9-digit Carleton Banner ID, if applicable. If you do not have an ID #, please type in 000-000-000.
4. Finally, we require an updated CV be attached to the application form, in approved format.
