Breadth Requirement

Must complete at least 1.0 credit in three of the four breadth areas (for a total of 3.0 credits):

- 1. Culture and Communication:** ARAB, ARTH, ASLA, CHIN, CLST, COMS, ENGL, ESLA, FILM, FINL, FREN, GERM, GREK, HEBR, ITAL, JAPA, JOUR, LANG, LATN, MPAD MUSI, PORT, RUSS, SPAN
- 2. Humanities:** AFRI, CDNS, CHST, CLCV, DBST, DIST, EURR, HIST, HUMR, HUMS, INDG, LACS, LING, MEMS, PHIL, RELI, SAST, SXST, WGST
- 3. Science and Engineering and Design:** AERO, ARCC, ARCH, ARCN, ARCS, ARCU, BIOC, BIOL, CHEM, CIVE, CMPS, COMP, ECOR, ELEC, ENSC, ENVE, EARTH, FOOD, HLTH, IDES, ISCI, ISCS, ISYS ITEC, MAAE, MATH, MECH, NEUR, NSCI, PHYS, SREE, STAT, SYSC, TSES
- 4. Social Sciences:** ANTH, BUSI, CGSC, CRCJ, ECON, ENST, GEOG, GEOM, GINS GPOL, INAF, IPAF, LAWS, PADM, MGDS, PAMP, POLM, PSCI, PSYC, SOCI, SOWK
