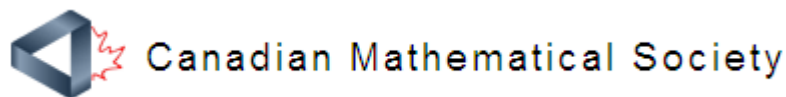


Contest Results 2013-2014

American Mathematics Competitions

Announcement related to AMC8 – 2013

Math Enrichment Centre, part of School of Mathematics and Statistics, Carleton University administered in Nov 19, 2013, the AMC8 Contest, 25 questions, 40 minute multiple choice examination in middle school mathematics. The contest was organized by MAA's American Mathematics Competitions. 51 students, most of them trained at Math Enrichment Centre, competed with 1,969 Canadian Students and 148,483 world-wide students.

3 Distinguished Honor Rolls (scores in the first 1 percent, score ≥ 22 out of 25)

17 Honor Rolls (scores in the first 5 percent, score ≥ 18)

3 Achievement Rolls (6th grade or below and score ≥ 15)

Carleton University-School of Mathematics and Statistics received a **School Honor Roll**. Based on the top three students for each school, Carleton received the 8th place in Canada, and the 4th place in Ontario with 67 points out of 75.
