

How to Edit your Zoom Recordings

There are several free and easy-to-use softwares you can employ to edit your Zoom recordings.

For PC computers, we generally recommend using Movie Maker 10, which is perfect for very simple edits. You can find out more about this software [here](#).

Another option for PC users is [Shotcut](#), a free open-source video editing tool that provides slightly more editing control than Movie Maker 10. You can watch the tutorials for Shotcut [here](#).

For those using a Mac, the editing softwares we recommend are Quicktime and [iMovie](#).

If you didn't know, QuickTime player allows you to trim the beginning and end of your videos, allows you to, remove audio/video, and even add a clip to the end of the video. You can learn more about QuickTime's editing capabilities [here](#).
