

## Difference Between Zoom's Basic License and Pro License

In terms of Carleton's usage, the major difference between a basic license and a pro license is the duration and capacity of meetings:

### Basic licenses:

- Basic licenses can host up to 300 participants for up to 40 minutes at a time; or 1-on-1 meetings for an unlimited time.

### Pro licenses:

- Pro licenses can host up to 300 participants for unlimited lengths of time. Pro licenses will be provided on a temporary basis for the term(s) needed.
