Course Title	Sensory and Motor Neuroscience
Course Description	Exploration of major topics in sensory processing and motor control, with a focus on underlying mechanisms and neurobiological principles. Topics include all sensory systems (such as vision, somatosensation and audition) plus motor system components including lower and upper motor neurons, basal ganglia, and cerebellum.
Course Credit Value	.5
Anticipated Modality	In-person
Anticipated Course Enrolment	120
Anticipated TA Support	Anticipated 2 TAs @ 130 hours if enrolment hits the target of 120. Course will have four lab sections and allotted 2 TAs @ 130 hours each for every lab section.
Required qualifications	Candidates should be proficient in the English language and have a graduate degree in Neuroscience. Priority will be given to candidates whose research and/or teaching expertise is a strong match with the core material of the course being taught. Please include a cover letter that describes your suitability for the course you are applying to teach.
