- 1. The names of all authors with the presenting author and institutional affiliation indicated;
- 2. The student's department, program type (BA, BSc, MA, MSc, PhD, etc.) and supervisor's name;
- 3. The presentation title;
- 4. Preference for an oral or a poster presentation; and
- 5. An abstract of 250 words maximum, which should include a brief introduction to your topic, research objectives, approach/methods, and key findings.
