To be eligible to participate in the accelerated pathway option, students must have a minimum overall CGPA of A- in their undergraduate courses. Preliminary approval to take courses can be granted in advance of all grades being available, however, the MA Program Supervisor/Graduate Administrator will review your CGPA prior to approving graduate level course registration.
