


Providing a vital industry resource: an open source platform making US nonprofit data more accessible.



Year-to-Date Nonprofit Sector Trends Q4 2023 (JAN 1, 2023 - DEC 31, 2023)

Key Insights

- In 2023, we observed a modest decline in fundraising metrics across most donor categories, including dollars raised, donor counts, and retention rates.
- · Small organizations performed the best in terms of dollars raised, remaining flat or slightly positive, with the largest organizations seeing the greatest decrease in fundraising.
- . The International, Foreign Affairs cause area saw a noticeable boost in Q4 of 2023, likely attributed to aid and assistance campaigns relating to international conflicts.



GivingTuesday Data Commons has partnered with the Donor Advised Fund Research Collaborative (DAFRC) to contribute to an increased public understanding of donor advised funds (DAFs). The Donor Advised Fund Research Collaborative (DAFRC), led and co-founded by Dr. Danielle Vance-McMullen and Dr. H. Daniel Heist, contributes to the public understanding of donor-advised funds (DAFs) by collecting the most recent data on DAF accounts and analyzing their characteristics and giving behavior. Published in February 2024, the 2024 National Study on Donor Advised Funds is the most comprehensive research project on DAFs to date.


