Impact on Parking

- P9 Permit holders will have option of moving to P7 or P18
- P9 accessible permit spaces will move to University Drive, in front of Maintenance Building
- Visitor & Campus Tours & BOG office will have option of: P2, P4B, P10 lots

P9 Electric Vehicle Charging Stations will be moved to new location



Demolition Overview

- Area around the site will be hoarded off April 2024
- Demolition scheduled to begin May 2024 until September 2024
- North pathway around Pigiarvik and south access to Science Technology Centre may be impacted
- Noise, dust and vibration to be expected
