
Please have this worksheet on hand throughout the workshop (either printed out or downloaded in an editable format), this will be an important tool we will be using.

In small groups discuss a core theme from the Rafter reading and prepare short summary to share with group.



Key Vocabulary!

Criminology- The study of crime and criminal behaviour; which are defined by reference to criminal law

Criminal Justice System- The various institutions and processes through which an offender passes, such as the police, the courts, and correctional facilities

Deviance- Behaviour that differs from accepted social norms; may include acts that violate specific rules, or behaviours

Net Widening- Imposing a form of control on individuals who might otherwise not be subject to that control.
