

Carleton University Walker Wood Award

Awarded on the recommendation of the Director of the Paul Menton Centre, to outstanding students with a demonstrated permanent disability, entering any program of study at Carleton University. Eligible students must be Canadian Citizens. Preference will be given to students in financial need. This award may be renewed for 3 consecutive years of full-time enrolment (minimum of 3.0 credits over the Fall/Winter session). Established in 2019 by the Walker Wood Foundation.

This award is valued at \$4,000 for the 2020/2021 academic year and renewable at \$4,000 for 3 years.

Application deadline: August 31, 2020

General Selection Criteria

- Canadian citizen
- Students with a permanent disability registered with the Paul Menton Centre
- Students entering the first-year of an undergraduate degree program at Carleton University and pursuing post- secondary studies for the first time
- Demonstrated financial need
- Demonstrated academic promise and leadership, participation in extra-curricular secondary school activities or community service
- Preference may be given to students who are passionate about advocating for disabilities and to students from Atlantic Canada

This award may be continued for 3 consecutive years of undergraduate study provided the recipient maintains full time enrolment in an undergraduate degree program (registers in and completes a minimum of 3.0 credits over the Fall/Winter session), remains in good academic standing and continues to demonstrate financial need. If the award is lost in one year, it cannot be regained in a subsequent year.
