Awarded annually on the recommendation of the Paul Menton Centre to an outstanding undergraduate student entering or proceeding from one year to another at Carleton University. Eligible students will have a permanent disability and be registered with the Paul Menton Centre and must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada.

Preference will be given to a female student. Established by CFUW-Ottawa Club at the request of Fran Harding and funded through generous donations from Fran and other CFUW-Ottawa Club members. It is named in honour of Susan Scott Parker, a Canadian, who is an advocate for the rights of disabled persons in the United Kingdom. Revised 2017.

The scholarship is valued at \$2000. The value of the award can vary from year to year.

- · Applicant must have a documented permanent disability
- · Applicant must be registered with the Paul Menton Center
- · Applicant must demonstrate academic excellence
- Applicant must be an undergraduate student entering or proceeding from one year to another in academic program at Carleton University
- · Preference will be given to a female student
