Established by CFUW-Ottawa Club at the request of Fran Harding and funded through generous donations from Fran and other CFUW-Ottawa Club members. It is named in honour of Susan Scott Parker, a Canadian, who is an advocate for the rights of disabled persons in the United Kingdom.	• Must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada • Must have a documented permanent disability • Must be registered with the Paul Menton Center • Must demonstrate academic excellence • Must be an undergraduate student entering or proceeding from one year to another in academic program at Carleton University • Preference will be given to a female student
Chloe Graf Memorial Scholarship	Awarded annually to an outstanding undergraduate student enrolled in the History program and an outstanding undergraduate student enrolled in the Women's and Gender Studies program proceeding from one year to another. Preference will be given to students with a permanent disability who are registered with the Paul Menton Centre. Endowed in 2020 in loving memory of Chloe Graf by her family to honour her passion for learning. Chloe was enrolled in the History program and received the John and Carol Strong Book Prize for outstanding writing.
