Recipient will have **demonstrated financial need**, must be Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada (landed immigrant or protected person), and must meet OSAP's Ontario residency requirements. Endowed in 2005 by family, friends and colleagues of David J Bellamy, former faculty member of the Department of Political Science.

*This award is valued at \$3,000 for the 2025/2026 academic year.*

- Enrolled in an undergraduate degree program in the Department of Political Science and is proceeding from Third to Fourth year of the program.
- Outstanding academic achievement
- Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada (landed immigrant or protected person)
- Eligible students will be asked to complete financial need application
- Must meet OSAP's Ontario residency requirements
