COURSE DESCRIPTION/INSTRUCTORS STATEMENT

This course provides students with the opportunity to conduct research in their area of interest and present the data in an undergraduate thesis format. A thesis project is conducted under the direct supervision of a faculty advisor from the *Department of Psychology*.

Fall Term - Regular weekly classes are scheduled for this course. Topics covered include aspects of the thesis process (e.g., working with supervisors, applying for ethics), as well as practical issues in pursuing academic/career pathways in Psychology (e.g., scholarships, clinical vs. experimental programs, graduate school, journal article publication process).

Winter Term – Scheduled office hours will allow for individual meetings with thesis students as needed.
